About Us

Greece Christian Preschool provides a rich classroom environment where children are encouraged to explore and challenged to learn, while making friends and developing self-confidence. Our curriculum helps children develop the thinking and problem solving skills they'll need to succeed in kindergarten.

- Classes follow the Greece Christian School calendar.
- Classes run from 9:15am-11:45am.
- Children must be completely toilet trained and able to use the restroom independently.
- Any child who turns 3 years old by December 1st can attend the three year old program.
- A child who turns 4 years old by December 1st can attend the four year old program.



How will my child benefit?

- Language and Literacy: daily activities develop reading and writing readiness.
- Math and Science: children are introduced to cognitive skills such as: patterning, number recognition, and counting.
- Creativity and Imagination: children showcase their creativity through dramatic play, music, and art.
- Physical Development: children develop their large motor skills such as running, jumping, throwing, and kicking.
- Spiritual Development: children are given an awareness of God as recorded in the Bible.

Group play is an integral part of the morning as they learn appropriate social skills and behavior.
